



PPG Re-certification Training

This course will update the technicians on any new products and techniques in either the *Deltron*® or *Global Refinish System (GRS)* family of products. This program is a training requirement for technicians participating in PPG's continuing education program for Certified Technicians. Completion of this course moves the technician up to the next level of PPG Certified Technician status and continues the benefits that are part of the program.

Who Should Attend:	Only Certified Technicians whose 2-year certification is due to be renewed. Students should attend either the <i>Deltron</i> or <i>GRS</i> Recertification depending on what system their shop uses
Course Objective:	To renew PPG certification and update technicians on new PPG products that have been developed since attending their last certification class
Course Length:	1 or 2 days*

The Student will be Able to:	Understand how to work safely in their shop environment Demonstrate proper application techniques Explain the importance of proper equipment setup Recognize the multiple uses of a single high solids undercoat Perform troubleshooting to understand what may have occurred for a variety of paint related problems and how to prevent it from happening again Properly use tinted sealers Select the most productive high solids clearcoat for their application environment
